Research Talent Hub (RTH)

To nurture and bring together more technology talent and encourage them to pursue a career in innovation and scientific research, the RTH was launched to provide funding support to the corporates. Each eligible applicant can engage up to 4 research talents at any one time. The allowance for research talents with a bachelor degree, for those with a master degree, and for those with a doctoral degree varies, offering flexibly to corporates to find the right talents.
