Using Technological Services and Solutions with Protection Why Should SMEs Care Cyber Security?

In recent years, it is common to hear that many enterprises are threatened by cyber attackers. Cyber threats continue to grow in scale and sophistication. SMEs has to stay cautious and be aware of the potential cyber security problems and emerging threats.



To fight against cyber attacks and minimise the risk of loss and threats to companies, SMEs may consider to adopt various cyber security solutions with Government funding support by applying for **Technology Voucher Programme** (TVP). The Government has launched TVP in November 2016, providing funding support to enterprises/organisations to improve productivity, or upgrade or transform their business processes. TVP covers hardware and software procurement and consultancy service. Non-listed enterprises with substantive business operation in HK are eligible to apply.
